# Aquatic Therapy at Hurley SportsCare

Hurley SportsCare, located inside the Hurley Health & Fitness Center, is Hurley's exclusive location for aquatic therapy services. Aquatic therapy can be offered when land-based exercise programs are not possible due to the patient's intensity of pain, decreased bone density, disability or other factors. Aquatic therapy is a versatile program and can be particularly helpful for patients with diagnoses



including, but not limited to, low back pain, arthritis, fibromyalgia and degenerative joint disease. Treatment plans are tailored to the individual. The exercises serve to condition and strengthen muscles to help avoid future recurrences of pain.

The physical properties of water make it a highly effective medium in which to exercise. Some of the most important properties of water which make exercises easier are buoyancy and viscosity. Water counteracts gravity, and helps support the weight of the patient, therefore allowing a greater range of motion due to the near elimination of gravitational forces. In chest deep water, 85% of the body's weight is eliminated. The water provides resistance by means of gentle friction, allowing strengthening and conditioning of an injury, while reducing the risk of further injury due to loss of balance. One of the greatest benefits of aquatic therapy is that the perception of pain may be diminished as a result of factors associated with the water, making it a different and often very pleasant therapy experience.
